### SINGLE-FAMILY HEAT PUMP WATER HEATER INCENTIVES

| Replacement Scenario   | Equipment Criteria   | Total Incentive Per Unit                     |

| Gas/propane to HPWH  | 45 & 50 gallons  | \$3,100                                      |
|  | 65 & 80 gallons  | \$3,800                                      |
| Electric resistance to HPWH  | 45 & 50 gallons  | \$3,100                                      |
|  | 65 & 80 gallons  | \$3,800                                      |
| Electrical Upgrades – must be completed under contractors' license | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Replace/upgrade/relocate main service panel</li> <li>• Install subpanel</li> <li>• Install smart load center/circuit breaker</li> <li>• Upgrade feeder and/or secondary disconnect/dwelling unit main disconnect</li> </ul> | 50% of electrical upgrade cost up to \$2,000 |
